



ASIA WEEK- A WINDOW INTO ASIA

FESTIVAL from 21 – 23 May



During Education Week Elwood Primary School will be celebrating by learning about the wonderful cultures of our Asian neighbours. During class this week the students will learn about a focus country of Asia; Level One (Prep) – Indonesia; Level Two (Grades 1 & 2) – Japan; Level Three (Grades 3 & 4) – China; and Level Four (Grades 5 & 6) – Korea.

We encourage students to start bringing any cultural items or photos that they may have about their focus country to display in the classroom. If you have any experiences with these countries that you would like to share with the children please approach your child's teacher to arrange a forum for this to take place.

WEDNESDAY 23 MAY: Asian Dress, Asian performance & Asian Lunch Day

On Wednesday 23 May children may come dressed in a costume from any Asian country. It can be as simple as a sarong over their uniform or a martial arts outfit or head band. The children are asked to bring a gold coin to donate to our sister school which will help sponsor a local Balinese child to attend school in Ubud. The children will also watch a fantastic Asian performance by some special guests during the day.

ASIAN LUNCH: On this Wednesday your child **may choose** to order an Asian lunch or bring their own Asian lunch. Options include the usual Wednesday Sushi lunch order or a Chinese lunch order. If your child would like Chinese lunch they must return their order by this Friday 18 May, orders will not be taken later than this!

Normal bakery lunch orders will also be available.

- 2) Return lunch orders to the special **Chinese lunch order box** that will be placed in the office in the senior school and in the hall entrance in the Junior school.
THEY MUST BE RETURNED NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 18 MAY.
- 3) Chinese lunches will be delivered to the classroom with the other orders.
